### **Student's Right to Know Disclosure Completion Rates**

The Student Right-to-Know Act requires an institution that participates in any student financial assistance program under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (as amended) to disclose information about graduation rates to current and prospective students.

The **2008 Cohort Completion Rate** for students in full time programs at Fortis Institute - Erie was **51.0%**. This rate is based on the 1,364 students who started their training between September 1, 2008 and August 31, 2009. Of the 1,364 students who started their program, 696 students completed their program of study within 150% of normal completion time for the longest eligible program offered by Fortis Institute - Erie. The above data excludes 107 students whose last date of attendance was less than 30 days after the first class day of their program that was greater than one academic year in length and students whose last date of attendance was less than 15 days after the first class day of their program that was less than or equal to one academic year in length.

The combined **2008 Cohort Completion Rate** for students in full time programs at the campuses attached to the OPEID (Office of Post Secondary Education Identification) number 030108 was **56.7%**. The OPEID number is comprised of Fortis Institute - Erie, Fortis College – Landover, and Fortis Institute - Birmingham. This rate was based on the students who started their training between September 1, 2008 and August 31, 2009. Of the 2,264 students who started their program, 1,283 students completed their program of study within 150% of normal completion time for the longest eligible program offered by OPEID number 030108. The above data excludes 142 students whose last date of attendance was less than 30 days after the first class day of their program that was greater than one academic year in length and students whose last date of attendance was less than 15 days after the first class day of their program that was less than or equal to one academic year in length.
